CMMC Compliance Jam Wichita is for all companies that directly or indirectly supply to the DoD as a contractor, subcontractor or supplier who are or will be subject to CMMC and DFARS 252.204-7012. Managed Service Providers (MSPs) with clients or prospective clients subject to CMMC will also find value from CMMC Compliance Jam Wichita.

Using FutureFeed, we'll help you through the process of assessing your organization's current state versus the requirements of NIST SP 800-171 and build projects to remediate gaps and bring your organization into compliance.

Who Should Participate?

We don't expect that you'll have all the information at hand you may need.

You'll be able to use FutureFeed for 30 days to add missing information and assess additional controls. We recommend having someone familiar with business operations and someone from IT participate on behalf of your company in CMMC Compliance Jam Wichita. And if you're using a Managed Service Provider (MSP) or Managed Security Service Provider (MSSP), ask them to join as well.

What Should I Bring?

1. Bring yourself and your knowledge of your organization and its IT environment (you may want to bring a colleague or two if you are new or focused on a specific area of the business).
2. A Laptop
3. Lists – Whatever you have with respect to your people, IT environment and tools, and documents
4. A way for you to login to your company network remotely (Optional)
